




CWS-NS Updates

Intake

- Completed Elastic Search query refinement for more accurate results when searching for individuals in the child welfare system.
- Completed several User Permissions (see Notes)
- Completed functionality to notify the user of system and database errors so they can be reported.
- Corrected the way that unnecessary CWS/CMS fields are automatically completed.
- Reduced the number of mandatory data fields the user must complete to save a referral in CWS/CMS.
- Deployed the first version of a shared library of design assets that all digital service teams can use for a uniform user interface.
- Completed Hispanic/Latino data fields.

Certification, Approval and Licensing Services (CALs)

- Completed initial automation of Resource Family Approval application form RFA 01A (testing still to come).
 - Began development of automating application form RFA 01B.
 - Demonstrated capability to create a new facility in CWS/CMS that populates data appropriately to all tables where facility data is required.
 - Demonstrated capability to auto-populate a ready-to-print PDF form from legacy and new system data.
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CWS-NS Updates

Case Management

- Completed onsite visits with Sacramento, Los Angeles, and Lassen counties.
- Developed a global header for project use across all digital services so that users will have a consistent experience across the platform.
