

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Placement Homes are being cleaned up as part of R8.6 implementation. Some of this clean up could result in homes being closed, merged or deleted. Currently Counties are engaged in Placement Home de-duplication with on-going efforts related to semi-annual reports, “Fuzzy” reports and possibly County-created reports.

It would be beneficial to Counties if they avoided working on homes that could possibly be cleaned automatically in R8.6.

WHAT HOMES SHOULD I AVOID MANUALLY CLEANING UP?

The criteria for cleanup in R8.6 implementation (and therefore a home that should be avoided for manual cleanup) is as follows:

- Duplicate “Group Home” types: Will be automatically merged into 1 master record;
- Homes that have never had any placements made against them (typically converted homes from 1997): Will be deleted;
- Homes that have never had any placements made against them. However, they have had other associations (e.g. Court appointed, Payee): Will be end-dated and hidden from search
- NREFM homes that have not had an assessment in the past 2 years: Will be end-dated and hidden from search
- Homes created with no Facility Name: (mostly from converted 1997 homes) Will have a name automatically created

IF A HOME DOES NOT MEET THIS CRITERIA?

If you are looking at merging homes that do not fall into the above criteria, then you can continue to work on that cleanup.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN AFTER R8.6?

Once the cleanup has been implemented after R8.6, you can continue to perform cleanup without restriction. Notification will be sent out once the R8.6 automated cleanup has occurred.
